**DO YOU HAVE UNPAID
AMBULANCE BILLS?**

**DID YOU KNOW NIHB PAYS FOR
AMBULANCE SERVICES UNDER OUR
TREATY RIGHT TO HEALTH?**

Facts:

- You have up to one (1) year after, to qualify for coverage under the NIHB Medical Transportation program.
- Unpaid ambulance bills will go to collections and will affect your credit.
 - bills already in collections less than one (1) year can be reversed for payment.
- NIHB is the last payer of resort; other insurance will cover first.
 - Example. Motor Vehicle Collision (MVC)
 - MVC includes Vehicle, snowmobile, ATV, Side-by-side, motorcycle, etc.
- MVC related ambulance bills are required to be paid by Auto Insurance, if auto insurance does not pay, ask for a denial letter to submit to the NIHB program for payment.
